This interactive workshop looks at some of the main pronunciation challenges that second language users face. For example:

- How to **pronounce words** taken from the academic word list **accurately**. This is a list of the most frequently used words in academia
- When to **pause naturally** in a sentence (utterance) so that you do not overload the listener with information or sound robotic
- How intonation (the rise and fall of your voice) can be used to communicate different kinds of meaning
- How sounds change in **natural speech** (connected speech)
